Vice President Agrifolio has spoken with the VP of Student Affairs, Dr. Christopher Catching, over the last month and discussed how the students are feeling this year and any improvements that need to be made. He has continued his work in communications between students and Senators with in person meetings in the Student Senate Office Suite 212 in the Campus Center. He has been working to find a virtual way of hosting office hours and by November, there will be a link to a Microsoft team that will be accessible to all students, faculty and staff by Stockton email. Vice President Agrifolio reminds students that they can email Senators, as well as Katie and himself, and the emails can be found on the Student Senate page on the Stockton website or Ospreyhub. Chair Bygrave opens up by hoping everybody had a good weekend. Chair Bygrave thanks representatives of the Gymnastics Club for joining the meeting and adds that they are here to discuss their supplemental request of \$8,000. Organization also submitted purchase requests. Other requests were for no more than \$1,500. Chair Bygrave reminds everyone that if they have any questions, he is around.

Chair Bygrave then asks the representatives of the Gymnastic Club to introduce themselves. The president of the Gymnastics Club, Kassia, starts off by saying she is honored to be attending today's meeting to present their request. They were given a budget of approximately \$7,500 for this year, but due to mistakes with insurance and payments, it depleted their budget almost immediately. Currently, the Gymnastics Club has a budget of \$0, but still have necessary payments to make, such as rent for the place they practice in and competitions. They requested \$8,000 which is more than they needed last time because a new coach was also hired, therefore \$500 from the requested amount will be going to paying the second coach.

President Champion opens the floor to Senators with any questions or concerns about the request. Chair Murray asks Chair Bygrave about the budget that they are working with now. Chair Bygrave answers saying that their budget is about the same and has not changed.

President Champion asks the representative if the full \$8,000 will be used solely for paying the coaches. In response to President Champion, Kassia explains that they have two coaches to pay and that one of the coaches owns the gym they use to practice so a majority of the money would be going to that coach. The club does need a total of \$8,500

and their club will be fundraising for the other \$500 needed. President Campion also asks how the budget will play when it comes to their future competitions. Kassia answers that things are very uncertain right now with Covid-19 and there's no way to fully plan events, but she hopes to host at least one home meet and travel locally so long as guidelines allow it. Any money needed when doing competitions is lower and is going to be done by fundraising. She mentions that there is the possibility she will come back to ask for more money if Nationals happen next semester. President Campion also asks how many people are on the gymnastics team. The president of the Gymnastics Club responds by saying that they have about 15-20 consistent members. President Campion asks when tryouts are and how they are run depictly. Kassia explains that the gymnastics team does not have tryouts or a cut process. The team is very varied with skill level, therefore some gymnasts are advanced while others may have never done something like this before. There is no dismissing of anybody, although she says the team offers a trial period for all new members.

Chair Payamps asks how much membership fees are for their members. Kassia states that membership fees are \$40 per member per semester. In response to her answer, Chair Payamps asks if they have considered raising the price of the membership fee to cover some of the costs. The president of the Gymnastics Club responds that the membership fees already do contribute towards rent cost and with paying the new coach. They did not expect to have to replenish their budget and didn't expect to need to pay for a second coach, therefore the membership fees had already been raised from \$30 to \$40. Chair

Payamps asks when they decided to hire a second coach. Kassia responds saying that their team has been growing exponentially over the past year and with the varying skill levels, they have a very defined split between those who are advanced and those who are beginners and then safety issues play a role. The coach they have now has been long considering who to bring on to help everything and everyone function safely.

Chair Murray says how she thinks it's amazing how the gymnastics team is very welcoming of all people of all skill levels and is happy to hear that there are no cuts of any kind and enjoys hearing that their ultimate goal is to spread the joy of gymnastics to anyone who wants to learn.

Senator Hunte asks how much money do they estimate to fund this year in regards to Nationals. Kassia responds by saying that she has not done exact calculations for going to Nationals because she is uncertain of what is to come, but will put a number on it soon. Nationals, in general, is expensive to think about because they would have to fly on a plane to Albuquerque, New Mexico where Nationals are planned to be held, as well as hotel accommodations. She estimates that the trip alone would be about \$10,000 and is uncertain of how it will be split up. Local competitions however will cost about \$300 to \$400 each and will be fundraised.

Jeff Wakeman comes on and states that by his calculations, the supplemental account started with \$84,000 and less than \$1,000 has been taken out combined from the other

financial committee transactions and with the confirmation of the Gymnastics Club request, would leave the supplemental account at about \$75,000.

- C. The Student Senate shall have an Executive Cabinet, comprised of the following:
 - i. President
 - ii. Vice President
 - iii. Finance Committee Chair
 - iv. Student Affairs Committee Chair
 - v. Academic Affairs Committee Chair
 - vi. Governmental Affairs Committee Chair
 - vii. Public Relations Committee Chair
 - viii. **Diversity & Inclusion Committee Chair**
- D. The Student Senate may appoint one or two Chiefs of Staff who assume the main responsibility of maintaining meeting minutes.
